### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)**

#### Introduction

National Highway Authority (NHA) intends to offer Bidders having relevant experience and registration of PEC in Operator Category of minimum O-3 or above, contract for **Operation**, **Management & Maintenance of Kuza Banda Service Area at Km-161 (North Bound) on Mansehra-Thakot Section of CPEC Havelian-Thakot on advance net guaranteed rental revenue basis**, in terms of advanced quarterly Net Guaranteed Rental Revenue Basis, which the Operator shall pay to the Employer in consideration of the right to utilize NHA's property/asset (medium for business) on North Bound Service Area through competitive bidding.

Briefly, the <u>Operator shall operate and manage the</u> <u>permissible Service Area buildings (already established by NHA) at its own cost</u> and the Operator has to pay advanced quarterly Net Guaranteed Rent to NHA. NHA reserves the right to utilize the vacant space (other than the established buildings) for any purpose whenever it deems fit/required and Operator shall not have claims to, and O&M for constructed buildings only, is being allowed to the Operator.

At **Annex-B**, map of entire established Service Area i.e. buildings and designated reserved plot for the establishment of Filling & CNG Station, is shown. This reserved plot is out of purview of OM&M of service area contract agreement. The operator will have no claims over this and a separate contract will be awarded for this reserved plot, through open & competitive bidding in accordance with PPRA Rules.

Bidders are hereby invited to submit their bid for the subject Contract.

The detailed brief in respect of Conditions of Contract (CoCs), Scope of Contract, Obligations and Covenants, Sample forms, etc. are given in this bidding document.

### 1. General Conditions of Contract (GCCs): -

- 1.1 Bidding is open to all interested Bidder(s) with the following must meet criteria:
  - a. PEC registered companies/partnership firms/sole proprietors, falling in operator category of minimum O-3 or above shall be eligible.
  - b. Any reputable and known Hotel with National 4-Star rating or 3-Star rating (3-diamond AAA) internationally is eligible to participate.
  - c. The interested Bidder(s) should not be blacklisted, defaulter or debarred from any of the government department(s) of Pakistan and NHA in any case/matter. In this regard, the prospective Bidder(s) shall submit undertaking on stamp paper to NHA that the firm is neither blacklisted/debarred nor defaulter (Specimen Form of the Undertaking is attached at Sample Forms).
- 1.2 The Operator shall operate and manage the permissible service area at its own cost. Enlistment of buildings along with their dimensions and purpose are given in **Annex-A**" (without detail of reserved plot for establishment of Filling & CNG station). On completion of contract period or its early termination, the Operator shall hand over the entire facility to NHA in a properly maintained and operational condition without any claim to cost.
- 1.3 **Annual Increment:** The net guaranteed rentals shall be increased @ 10% each year, cumulatively. **Explanation:** The net guaranteed Rentals shall be increased @ 10% each year on the basis of preceding/last year's net guaranteed rentals, cumulatively.
- 1.4 The Operator shall operate and manage the existing building(s) and shall not be allowed to establish/construct any new building(s) at or near the premises of the Service Area site, until/unless deems necessary with prior written approval of Design by the Employer. In case of necessity/urgency/any change in policy or special directions/instructions by Government of Pakistan, the same shall be allowed subject to the written approval of the Employer i.e. NHA.
- 1.5 Detailed Maps consisting of dimensions of buildings and their allocation/purposes are attached at **Annex-B**. The Operator shall also provide maintenance, utilities and cost for the utilities for all the permissible amenities. The procurement is for renting out NHA's assets; therefore, Inventory of Assets will be prepared by General Manager (Region/Project) along with Project Director/Deputy Director (Maint) concerned and shall be signed jointly at the time of Handing over/Taking over. The said inventory shall become part of this Bidding Document. The Operator shall be bound to hand over assets as per Inventory at expiry of the Contract, to the satisfaction of employer. (Inventory list should be attached)

- 1.6 For mobilization, the Grace Period of two (02) months from the date of issuance of commencement letter shall be allowed to the Operator on completion of which payment to NHA by the Operator shall become due.
- 1.7 The contract period shall be valid for five (05) years, further extendable for a period of two (02) years, subject thereof to satisfactory performance, mutual consent of both parties and thereof subject to approval by NHA.
- 1.8 The interested Bidder(s) shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for any such costs in any event whatsoever, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process. Bidder(s) must fully inform themselves of local conditions and all factors related to subject contract whatsoever and take these into account in preparing their bid.
- 1.9 The interested Bidder(s) are advised to visit and examine the Site (as defined in Section I.02 of Article I) and its surroundings and obtain for themselves on their own responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into contract. The Bidder(s) shall be deemed to have checked the traffic volume and prepared its bid accordingly; no claim(s) whatsoever in this regard shall be entertained thereafter. All costs in this respect shall be at the Bidder's expense.
- 1.10 Sub-letting of any facility(ies) by the Operator shall be allowed with the prior approval/permission of the Employer and in no case Operator will enter into a sub-let contract beyond its own contract period.
- 1.11 The Operator shall be responsible for resolving all the issues which arise between the Operator and any local authority(ies) during the currency of the Contract at its own risk & cost and shall indemnify NHA from all legal recourse.
- 1.12 All bids must be properly bound in hard form (to deny removal/addition of any documents), duly signed and stamped with continuous page numbering on all pages by the Bidder(s) for submission to NHA. Ring binding, spiral binding and box file form (with loose papers) will not be accepted and such bids shall be considered non responsive.
- 1.13 The Bidder(s) are required to examine carefully the contents of all the documents submitted in their bid. Failure to comply with the requirements of bid submission will be at the Bidders' own risk. Pursuant to Clause 16(b), bids which are not substantially responsive to the requirements of the Bidding Documents, will be rejected.
- 1.14 If there arises any discrepancy between bid amount quoted in words & figures, the amount quoted in words will prevail.

### 2. Single Stage Two Envelope System of Tendering/Bidding

- 2.1 The Employer has adopted Single Stage Two Envelope procurement procedure for this bidding in accordance with the PPRA Rule 36 (b).
- 2.2 The NHA will separately evaluate all Technical and Financial bids; therefore, Bidders are required to submit their Technical and Financial bids in two separately sealed "envelopes."
- 2.3 The NHA requires the first envelope, marked TECHNICAL BID, to contain the original and a set of copy (soft & hard) of the Bidder's technical bid. The NHA requires the second envelope, marked FINANCIAL BID, to contain the original and a set of copy (soft & hard) of the Bidder's financial bid. Bidders are cautioned to ensure that their Technical and Financial bids are contained in separately sealed envelopes clearly marked as indicated above. The NHA requires Bidders to submit the separately sealed envelopes in one bound package. In the event of any discrepancy between the original and copies, the original shall govern.
- 2.4 The original and copies of the Proposal shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to bind the Bidder to the offer. Proof of authorization shall be furnished in the form of a written original Power-of-Attorney, which shall accompany the Proposal. All pages of the Proposal, except for un-amended printed material, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the Proposal.
- 2.5 The complete Proposal shall be without alterations, interlineations or erasures, except as necessary to correct errors made by the Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the Proposal.
- 2.6 NHA will receive Technical & Financial Bids and will open the technical bids on the same day in the presence of all bidders/authorized representatives. The NHA will evaluate the technical bids and the financial bids of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened and announced. The financial bids of non-technically qualified bidders will be returned unopened.

### 3. Clarifications & Correspondence

3.1 Prospective Bidder(s) requiring any clarification(s) in respect of the Bidding Documents may notify the Employer in writing or by fax at the following address:

3.2 Employer will examine the request for clarification of the Bidding Documents, if received not later than ten (10) days prior to the

deadline for the submission of bids or during the Pre-Bid meeting, and shall issue a clarification minimum three (03) days before the date of submission of Bids (without identifying the source of enquiry) to all prospective bidders who have purchased or downloaded the Bidding Documents.

- 3.3 At any time prior to the submission/opening of bids, the Employer may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by issuing an addendum.
- 3.4 Any addendum/corrigendum thus issued shall become an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
- 3.5 To afford prospective bidders reasonable time in which to take an addendum/corrigendum into account in preparing their bids, the Employer may at its discretion extend the deadline for submission of bids.
- 3.6 Moreover, the Employer may also seek clarification through writing for any document/item(s) in the bid.
- 3.7 Name and address of the Employer is: **Chairman National Highway Authority** Mauve Area, G-9/1, Islamabad.
- 3.8 The authorized representative of the Employer is; General Manager (RoW-Rev) NHA-HQ, Islamabad.

### 4. One Bid per Bidder

4.1 Each bidder shall submit only one bid either by itself for each contract, otherwise bids submitted by it shall not be considered for evaluation and award.

#### 5. Bidders to Inform themselves

The bidders are advised to obtain for themselves at their own cost and responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into contract for operation and management of the Service Area. This shall include but not be limited to the following:

(a) Inquiries on Pakistani Income Tax/Sales Tax/Surcharge or any other Levy/Fee/Tax imposed by the Government of Pakistan, Provincial and District/Local Governments. NHA shall not be liable to pay any such Levies/Fee/Tax.

#### 6. Local Conditions

Bidder(s) must verify and supplement by its own investigations all necessary information about the site, traffic volumes local, conditions etc. for the purposes of filling and submitting its bid and entering into Contract. Any claim(s) in connection to or arising out of these

conditions will not be entertained during or after the completion of Contract period.

### 7. Pre-Bid Meeting

- 7.1 Prospective Bidders are invited, and strongly encouraged, to attend a pre-bid meeting, organized and to be conducted by NHA.
- 7.2 Prior to the Pre-Bid Meeting, Bidders are invited to submit written queries concerning the Contract requirements, the Bidding Documents or other related matters pertinent to the Contract.
- 7.3 All such queries should be submitted to the General Manager (Rev-RoW), NHA, within at least ten (10) working days prior to submission of bid.
- 7.4 The NHA will conduct the pre-bid meeting, record all questions, both written and verbal, posed by Bidders, record all answers provided thereto, and provide a written Pre-Bid meeting Memorandum or, if required, amendment through Addendum/corrigendum in the Bidding Documents, to each Bidder.
- 7.5 The NHA will not, during the Pre-Bid meeting, modify in any material respect any provision or term of this Bidding Documents unless such modification is made as a written Addendum thereto prepared by the NHA and disseminated to all the Bidders.

### 8. Bid Validity

- 8.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period of One Hundred and Twenty (120) days after the date of bid submission.
- 8.2 In exceptional circumstances prior to expiry of original bid validity period, the Employer may request the bidders to extend the bid validity for a specified additional period which shall in no case be more than the original bid validity period. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiture of its Bid Security. A bidder agreeing to the request will be required to extend the validity of its Bid Security for the period of the extension, in accordance with PPRA Rule 26.

### 9. Bid Security

9.1 Each bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, a Bid Security in the amount of Pak. Rupees 1,000,000/- (Rupees one million only).

- 9.2 The Bid Security shall be in the form of Pay Order issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan acceptable to the Employer in favor of the "National Highway Authority, Road Maintenance Account, Islamabad" valid for a period twenty-eight (28) days beyond the bid validity date.
- 9.3 The Bid Security is required to protect the Employer against the risk of bidder's conduct which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to Sub-Clause 9.8, hereof.
- 9.4 Any bid not accompanied by an acceptable Bid Security, shall be rejected by the Employer forthwith as being non-responsive, pursuant to Clause 9.8.
- 9.5 Any amount of bid security which is lying with the Employer for any previous bidding process shall not be considered for this bidding.
- 9.6 The bid security of all participating bidders will be returned as promptly as possible except for the highest bidder, which will be returned upon award of the Contract to the successful bidder under clause 23, or on the expiry of validity of Bid Security under clause 8, whichever is earlier subject to rights of parties.
- 9.7 The Bid Security of the Successful Bidder will be returned when the bidder furnishes the pre-requisites of the Contract i.e. Performance Security, Revenue Security and Advance tax payable u/s 236A of the Income Tax Ordinance 2001 and signs the Contract, pursuant to Clause 9.6.
- 9.8 The Bid Security may be forfeited:
  - (a) if a bidder withdraws its bid during the original period of bid validity; or
  - (b) if a bidder does not accept the arithmetic correction of its Bid Price, or
  - (c) in the case of Operator, if it fails to:
    - (i) furnish the pre-requisites of the Contract in accordance with Clause 23.1 (a); or
    - (ii) sign the Contract, in accordance with Clause 22.

### 10. Documents Comprising of Bid

- 10.1 The bid to be submitted by the interested bidder shall be legible and comprise the following documents:
  - a. Envelope-A (Documents Consisting Must Meet Criteria)
    - ✓ Certificate confirming the receipt as per clause 27,
    - ✓ Valid PEC license of Operators minimum category O-3, or above
    - ✓ Relevant Experience Certificate,
    - ✓ In case of Hotel industry, prof of having registered hotel business,
    - ✓ Bid Security.
    - ✓ Undertaking (refer GCC clause 1.1c) must be as per the given specimen (sample attached at Sample Forms)

- b. **Envelope-B** (Documents Consisting Financial Bid)
  - ✓ Financial bid
- 10.2 Both of the above envelops should be sealed separately and marked clearly as "Documents Consisting Must Meet Criteria (Original + Copy)" the first envelope and the "Financial Bid (Original + Copy)" the second envelope as under:

### 11. Format and Signing of Bid

- 11.1 All documents comprising Bid including Bid Form and Integrity Pact (Specimen Form of the Integrity Pact is attached at Sample Forms) shall be complete in all respects and properly signed and stamped by the bidder.
- 11.2 No alteration is to be made in the Form of Bid except in filling up the blanks as directed. If any alteration will be made or if these instructions not fully complied with, the bid may be rejected being non-responsive.
- 11.3 Each bidder shall prepare one (1) Original and one (01) Copy of the documents comprising the bid as described in Clause 10 and clearly mark them "ORIGINAL" and "COPY" as appropriate. In the event of discrepancy between them, the original shall prevail.
- 11.4 The original and a copy of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign them. This shall be indicated by submitting a written Power of Attorney authorizing the signatory of the bid to act for and on behalf of the Bidder. All pages of the bid shall be initialed and stamped by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 11.5 The bid shall contain no alterations, omissions or additions, except to comply with instructions issued by the Employer, or as are necessary to correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 11.6 Bidders shall indicate in the space provided in the Form of Bid their full and proper addresses at which notices may be legally served on them and to which all correspondence in connection with their bids and the contract is to be sent.
- 11.7 Bidders should retain a copy of the Bidding Documents as their file copy.

#### 12. Submission of Bids

- 12.1 Each bidder shall submit its bid as under:
  - a. One (01) ORIGINAL and one (01) COPY of the Bid shall be separately sealed and put in separate sealed envelopes and marked as such.
  - b. The envelopes containing the ORIGINAL and COPY will be put in one sealed envelope and addressed/identified as given in Sub-Clause 3.1, hereof.
- 12.2 The Bidder shall paste the Form duly filled in on the inner and outer envelopes as per given sample including;
  - a. be addressed to the Employer at the address given in Bidding Document.
  - b. bear the contract name and Date of opening of Bid.
  - c. provide a warning not to open before the time and date for bid opening.
- 12.3 The Bid shall be delivered in person or sent by registered mail at the address of the Employer as given above.
- 12.4 In addition to the identification required in Sub-Clause 12.1 hereof, the inner envelope shall indicate the name and address of the bidder to enable the bid to be returned unopened in case it is declared "late".
- 12.5 If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as above, the Employer will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the bid.
- 12.6 a) Bids must be submitted to the Employer at the address specified in the Bidding Documents not later than the time and date stipulated in the Bidding Documents.
  - b) Bids with charges payable shall not be accepted, nor will arrangements be undertaken to collect the bids from any delivery point.
  - c) Upon request, acknowledgment of receipt of bids will be provided to those making delivery in person or by messenger.
- 12.8 NHA shall receive and keep secure all bids submitted before the date and time specified for Bids Closing.
- 12.9 The Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids by issuing an Addendum; in such a case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

### 13. Language

All bids shall be prepared in the English language.

#### 14. Late Bids

- a. Any bid submitted to the Employer after the deadline for submission of bids shall returned unopened.
- b. Delays in the mail, delays of person in transit, or delivery of a bid to the wrong office shall not be accepted as an excuse for failure to deliver its bid at the proper place and time. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to determine the manner in which timely delivery of its bid will be accomplished either in person, by messenger or by post.

### 15. Bid Opening

- 15.1 A Committee consisting of nominated members by the Employer will open the bids in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend, at the time, date and location advertised in Invitation to Bid i.e.
  - At 1130 hrs. on Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021 in NHA Auditorium, 27-Mauve Area, G-9/1, Islamabad.
- 15.2 The bidders or their authorized representatives who are present shall sign in a register to evidence their participation.
- 15.3 The bidders' names, bid amounts and the presence or absence of Bid Securities, etc. will be announced by the Employer during the bid opening.

### 16. Determination of Responsiveness of Bids

- 16.1 Detailed evaluation of bids comprises of the following;
- (a) the Employer will examine the Bids to determine whether;
  - i. the Bid is complete and does not deviate from the requirements of the Contract,
  - ii. any computational errors have been made,
  - iii. required securities have been furnished,
  - iv. the documents have been properly signed and stamped,
  - v. the Bid is valid for the stipulated period,
  - vi. the quoted Bid price shall remain firmed during currency

of contract,

- vii. the Bidder fulfills the must meet criteria as per GCC clause 1.1 for Bid hereof, and
- (b) A bid is non responsive, if;
  - i. it is neither signed nor stamped;
  - ii. its validity is less than the specified period;
  - iii. it is not accompanied with Bid Security; or
  - iv. it is materially and substantially deviant from the requirements of the Bidding Documents;
- 16.2 If the Bidder does not accept the corrected amount of its Bid, it will be rejected and the corresponding Bid Security shall be forfeited.
- 16.3 In case of forgery, involvement in fraudulent activity(ies) or any misrepresentation/concealment made by the bidder while submitting its bid to NHA, the same shall lead towards forfeiture of its bid security and debarring/blacklisting.
- 16.4 A Bid determined as substantially non-responsive shall be rejected and cannot subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by rectification of the non-conformity.

#### 17. Evaluation of Bids

- 17.1 NHA intends to facilitate and sustain an environment of competitiveness, transparency and fairness in the procurement process by, among other means, fairly and impartially processing.
- 17.2 The NHA will examine the Bids to determine whether they are complete, whether the requisite Bid Securities have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the Bids are generally in order.
- 17.3 Financial Bids of only the responsive bidder(s) who fulfill(s) the criteria mentioned in Clause 10.1(a) will be opened, announced and put to comparison process. The financial bid(s) of non-responsive bidder(s) shall be returned un-opened.
- 17.4 From the date and time of Bid Opening until the time the Contract is awarded, any Bidder wishing to contact the NHA on any matter related to this bidding must do so in writing at the NHA's address noted above in clause 3.1.

### 18. Confidentiality

18.1 After the Bid Opening, information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Bids and recommendations concerning the award of a Contract shall not be disclosed to Bidders, or other persons not officially concerned with such process, until the award of the Contract is officially announced.

18.2 Any effort by a Bidder to influence the NHA in the process of examination, clarification, comparison and evaluation of Bids, or decisions concerning award of a Contract, may result in the rejection of that Bidder's Bid and forfeiture of his Bid security.

### 19. Employer's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or all Bids

As per PPRA Rule 33:

- i. The procuring agency may reject all bids at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid.
- ii. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid, the grounds for its rejection of all bids, but is not required to justify those grounds.
- iii. Notice of the rejection of all bids shall be given promptly to all bidders.
- iv. The procuring agency shall incur no liability.

#### 20. Award Criteria

The Employer will award the contract to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents and who has offered the highest paying evaluated bid price (net guaranteed rentals).

### 21. Security Deposits

21.1 The Operator shall furnish to the Employer the Performance Security, Rental Security (equal to advance quarterly rental) and Payment of applicable Taxes in the forms and the amounts stipulated below, within a period of fifteen (15) days after the receipt of Letter of Acceptance.

### a. **Performance Security**

The Performance Security shall be equal to 25% of the bid value of yearly net guaranteed rental. The Performance Security should be in form of Pay order drawn in favor of "Road Maintenance Account, National Highway Authority, Islamabad".

#### b. **Rental Security**

The Rental Security shall be equal to three (03) months net guaranteed rental amount, offered by the Operator. The Rental Security should be in form of Pay order in favor of the "National Highway Authority, Road Maintenance Account, Islamabad".

#### c. Payment of Taxes

The Operator shall deposit all applicable taxes more so, so amended from time to time by state, over and above the net guaranteed rentals, in advance in the form of Pay order in favor of the "National Highway Authority, Road Maintenance Account, Islamabad.

21.2 Failure of the Operator to comply with the requirements shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of its Bid Security.

#### 22. Notification of Award

- 22.1 Prior to expiration of the bid validity prescribed by the Employer, the Employer will notify the Operator in writing through a letter i.e. "Letter of Acceptance" that its bid has been accepted. This letter shall comprise the amount of Net Guaranteed Rental payable to the Employer.
- 22.2 The Letter of Acceptance and its acceptance by the bidder will constitute the formation of the contract, binding the Employer and the Operator till signing of the formal Contract for Guaranteed Rentals, subject to compliance of all the requisites, else the LoA will be deemed as withdrawn without any legal recourse to the non-compliant successful bidder.
- 22.3 Upon furnishing the Performance Security and other requisites by the Operator, the Employer will promptly notify the bidders that their bid has been successful and return their Bid Security.

### 23. Signing of Contract

- 23.1 Within a fortnight from the date of furnishing of acceptable Performance Security and other pre-requisites, under the Conditions of Contract, the Employer will send to the Operator the Form of Contract for Guaranteed Rental attached to the Bidding Documents.
- 23.2 The formal Contract between the Employer and the Operator shall be executed within a fortnight of the receipt of such Form of Contract by the Operator.

### 24. Due Diligence

- 24.1 NHA reserves the right to carry out due diligence in its sole discretion during procurement, award and execution of the Contract.
- 24.2 Bidders must adhere to the Contract location, as well as the site boundary limitations.

### 25. Integrity Pact

# ARTICLE I TERM OF THE CONTRACT AND CONTRACT SITE

### Section I. 01 Term

- a) The term of the Contract shall expire after Five (05) years (including grace period) further extendable for a period of two (02) years, subject to satisfactory performance, mutual consent of both parties and thereof subject to approval by NHA.
- b) The Effective Date of the Contract shall start from the date of issuance of Letter of Commencement (LoC).

### Section I. 02 Contract Site

- (a) Operator shall render the services solely within the Contract Site, as defined under sub-paragraph (b) and in accordance with the Clause 1.4 & 1.5 of GCC. For the purposes of this Contract, the Operator shall have no rights or obligations beyond the geographical limits of the Permissible Site.
- The Service Area offered to the Operator by NHA pursuant to (b) this Contract shall be at Kuza Banda Service Area on KM 161 North Bound of Mansehra-Thakot Section of CPEC Havelian-Thakot on Advance Net Guaranteed Rental Revenue Basis for Operation, Management & Maintenance. The Operator shall operate and manage the permissible Service Area at its own cost. On completion of Five (05) years' operation further extendable for a period of two (02) years, upon satisfactory performance, mutual consent of both parties and thereof subject to approval by NHA. the Operator shall handover all of the amenities/installations to NHA. Exact parameters of the area rented out to the Operator pursuant to this Contract ("Contract Site") is as per Annex-A & B pursuant to Clause 1.2 to 1.5 of GCC. It is further added that, the vacant plot, showing at Annex-B is reserved for the establishment of Filling Stations and the same is not included in this contract as awarded separately, thus, the successful operator shall have no right on this.

### Section I. 03 Definitions and Rules of Interpretation:

All capitalized terms used herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in this Contract.

- **a. "Authority"** means National Highway Authority, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad.
- **b. "Contract"** means the Contract for Guaranteed Rental, Articles, Conditions of Contract and Appendices.
- **c. "Contract Rental"** means the advance quarterly net guaranteed rentals payable to the Employer by the Operator as stated in the Letter of Acceptance (LoA).
- d. "Day" means the Calendar Day.

- **e. "Employer"** means the Chairman, National Highway Authority, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad.
- **f. "Employer's Representative"** means General Manager (RoW-Rev) NHA-HQ, Islamabad or any other person nominated in writing by the Employer from time to time.
- g. "ITB" means Instructions to Bidder.
- **h. "Modification of Contract"** is defined as a Contract in writing negotiated and signed between the Employer and the Operator for any change in the original agreement and any obligations associated therewith.
- i. "Operator" means the Operations, Management & Maintenance Operator running the Contract in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract and the Scope of Contract.
- **j. "Party"** means the Employer or the Operator as the case may be, and Parties means both of them.
- **k.** "Qualified Bidder" means the prospective bidder who fulfills must meet criteria as per Clause 1.1 of GCC.
- 1. "Rental Security" means the amount equal to the one advance quarter net guaranteed Rentals, which shall be deposited by the Operator to the Employer against security deposit.
- **m. "RoW"** means Right of Way, inclusive of all the ancillary land owned by NHA for usage by commuters.
- **n. "Scope of the Contract"** means provision of Operations and Management of facilities in accordance with the terms & conditions set in by this bidding document.
- **o. "Services"** means services required to be rendered by the Operator in accordance with various articles of the Contract.
- **p. "Site Location"** means the site of Service Area which includes established buildings as per **Annexure-B** offered for Operation and Management of Kuza Banda Service Area.

# ARTICLE II SCOPE OF CONTRACT AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

### Section II. 01 Scope of Contract

NHA hereby grants to the Operator subject to the terms and conditions of this Contract to operate, manage, maintain and provide other ancillary services, as enumerated under Section II. 02 ("Services"), with respect to the Contract Operation, Management & Maintenance of the Service Area.

### Section II. 02 Obligations and Covenants of the Operator:

The Services and the obligations of the Operator for contract shall include:

- a. Execution of the Work Plan, including interior designing of the restaurant at its own cost and expense; provided that the Operator shall not make any additions, alterations and/or modifications in the approved plan, either temporary or permanent, in or around the Contract Site without the prior written consent of NHA, pursuant to clause 1.4 of GCC.
- b. Ensuring routine maintenance, service and repair of the Restaurant and the amenities and fixtures at the Contract Site.
- c. Supply of hygienic, nutritious, fresh Halal food and beverages ("Edibles"), at the restaurant and the ancillary eating facilities already made at the Contract Site ("Restaurant"), at reasonable and competitive prevailing market prices; provided that the quality, menu and prices of the Edibles shall be subject to the review as per Govt. Policy and shall accord with established international health and hygiene standards; provided further that any revision or change in the quality, menu or prices of the Edibles shall be subject to the approval of Employer/Local Authority.
- d. Using good quality cutlery, utensils and furniture at the Restaurant; provided the said items match standard of high class restaurants and keep all parts in a sanitized and clean state;.
- e. Keeping all parts of the Contract Site, in particular the kitchen of the Restaurant(s), in a sanitized and hygienic state as per existing laws of the land.
- f. Providing appropriate waste/trash cans for the disposal of garbage/refuse/waste/trash ("Trash") in and around the

Contract Site and arranging for removal of Trash/garbage from the Contract Site every day.

- g. Establishing and maintaining a computerized sale system at the restaurants/amenities whereby a record of all the sales ("Record") at the Restaurant shall be maintained, as per existing laws of the land.
- h. Dedicating special tables in restaurants for elderly citizens and disabled persons.
- i. Dedicated parking on both sides of Service Area for senior citizens & disabled persons.
- j. Space for females in Masjid/prayer room.
- k. Ramps along all amenities for senior citizens/elderly persons/females.
- 1. Special staff for assistance of senior citizens and disabled persons at restaurants and wash rooms.
- m. Dedicated/specialized washrooms for senior citizens/disabled persons/females.
- n. Dedicated place near main parking area, for parking of wheelchairs with staff.
- o. Paying all utility bills, including, bills for electricity, gas, telephone, water and conservancy with respect to inter alia the operation, management and maintenance of the Restaurant and other amenities including Masjid, Tube Well, Street Lights, etc. at the Contract Site according to their usage in the restaurants. Failure will invite encashment of Performance Security & Rental Security.
- p. Operator shall provide new carpets, curtains in the Masjid and maintain/replace when needed, during the contract period. Moreover, he will be bound to arrange a suitable Imam Masjid, Moazin, Khudams, Mali and Sweepers (separate for service area and washrooms/toilets) on round the clock basis.
- q. Arranging, at its own expense, alternative/standby arrangements/ generators as necessary in the case of non-availability of electricity or load shedding for 24 hours, 07 days

a week and 12 months in a year. Moreover, in case of use of generator provided by NHA all costs associated with operation & maintenance shall be borne by the O&M Operator at its own cost. No reimbursement shall be made by NHA on this account and any other utilities installed at the service area.

- r. Maintaining a complaint register at the Contract Site at a clearly accessible and conspicuous/visible place including display of telephone/mobile number and e-mail address of the Operator as well as NHA. Monthly report to this effect shall be forwarded to NHA by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of every succeeding month, listing the complaints lodged with the name & phone number of the complainant during the preceding month and the corrective steps taken by the Operator in that regard.
- s. Providing suitable and well-organized 24 hours security arrangements like installation of CCTV Cameras on the entire Contract site and its surrounding area and Security Guards for the safety of commuters.
- t. Using the Contract Site solely for defined/given purposes of providing the Services and operation, managing and maintaining the restaurant and facilities.
- u. Supplying labor, materials, equipment and other resources necessary for the performance of the Services.
- v. Cooperating with NHA and any authorized person(s) or entity acting on NHA's behalf, with regard to the transfer of the Contract Site to NHA or any person(s) or entity nominated by NHA upon expiry or termination of this Contract.
- w. Maintaining effective Fire Fighting arrangements.
- x. Provide First Aid facility.
- y. Provide drug-free and hygienic services by establishing a drugfree atmosphere in compliance with Govt. policies.
- z. Providing potable drinking water for the use of general public by installation of electric water coolers one each at Masjid and outdoor sitting places for commuters.
- aa. Complying with all terms and conditions of this Contract and all instructions and directions of NHA, as provided from time to time.

# Section II. 03 In carrying out its obligations, the Operator represents and covenants that:

- a. There are no legal, criminal & financial default proceedings pending or threatened for the liquidation of the Operator or that could materially or adversely affect the performance by the Operator of its obligations under this Contract.
- b. The Operator shall at all times maintain its corporate existence in compliance with the Laws of Pakistan.
- c. The Operator shall procure and maintain all consent necessary to perform its obligations under this Contract, give all required notices and allow all required inspections under all consents obtained or applied for by it, in connection with this Contract.
- d. The Operator may assign, delegate or subcontract its rights and obligations pursuant to this Contract subject to the prior written approval of NHA as per clause 1.10 of GCC.
- e. This Contract has been duly authorized, executed and delivered by it and constitutes the irrevocable, legal, valid and binding obligation of it, and
- f. In the event of termination of this Contract by NHA for its convenience, the Operator shall have no rights to claim damages and shall not seek continuation of performance of services neither shall approach any court in an attempt to restrain NHA from assuming control of the subject/Contract Site.
- g. In no event shall termination for convenience be deemed a default by NHA under this contract.
- h. NHA shall have the right at any time and from time to time during the term, and for any reason whatsoever at NHA's sole discretion, to terminate this contract with respect to all or any portion of the services (such total or partial termination being referred to herein as a "Termination for Convenience"). NHA may exercise its right of Termination for Convenience by furnishing to Operator written notice of its election to do so, which notice shall specify the services that NHA has elected to remove from the scope and operation of this Contract. The Termination for Convenience as to such services shall be effective sixty (60) days following the date of such notice. Thereafter all references herein to "Services" shall be deem to refer only to those operation and management tasks that continue to be required to be performed by Operator hereunder. In the event of termination of this Contract by NHA for convenience the Operator shall not seek continuation of performance of services neither shall approach any court in an attempt to restrain NHA from assuming control of the contract site.

# Section II.04 Committee for Assessment of the Damages in case of termination at NHA's Convenience:

In case of early termination upon convenience of NHA, the following assessment committee will assess the claims for damages submitted by the Operator and recommendations in this regard shall be forwarded for perusal of the Chairman NHA through General Manager (Rev-RoW) for indemnifying the loss of Operator: -

# Section II.05 The Employer's Representations, Warranties and Covenants

NHA hereby represents and warrants to the Operator that as of the date of this Contract:

- a. It is duly created pursuant to the National Highway Authority Act, 1991 and has complied fully with all applicable Laws of Pakistan on award of contract;
- b. The Contract Site falls within the jurisdiction of NHA and that NHA is duly authorized under the Laws of Pakistan to enter into the contract with regard to the Contract Site/RoW;
- c. This Contract has been duly authorized, executed and delivered by it and constitutes the legal, valid and binding obligations of NHA; and
- d. NHA shall exercise its powers under the National Highway Authority Act, 1991, the rules and regulations framed there under and all other Laws of Pakistan and amendments made thereto in a manner that are consistent with this Contract;
- e. NHA shall use its good offices to support the Operator's performance of its business activities pursuant to the contract, but without assuming any liability or obligation in this regard unless expressly stated in this Contract;
- f. NHA shall make available or cause to be made available to the Operator the Contract Site, for Operation and Management of the Kuza Banda Service Area as per approved plan free of all encumbrances, lien and charge(s);
- g. NHA shall ensure that access to the Contract Site is not closed or restricted in any way;

- h. NHA may use its good offices if requested to facilitate the Operator in obtaining permissions and licenses required from time to time for the purposes of execution of the Contract, however it is not an obligation;
- i. NHA may grant or assist the grant or processing of applications for any work permits, employment passes, visas and other permits, as necessary for the Operator, its directors, employees, and other individuals employed for performance of its obligations pursuant to this Contract in accordance with the laws of Pakistan; and
- j. NHA will comply with all the terms and conditions of this Contract.

### Section II.06 Quality Assurance

For the purpose of Quality Assurance, bidder should have to follow the best international practices of quality assurance and checking procedure. Following yardsticks may be followed:-

- i. There shall also be a mechanism to keep clothing of the staff neat and clean at all the times.
- ii. The provision of food and services should be of National standards and at the notified prices by Government of Pakistan.
- iii. The staff shall be courteous to the road commuters and follow best practices while imparting services.
- iv. Only fresh and hygienic food stuff will be served 24 hours in the Service Area.
- v. There should be potable water/electric coolers installed duly visible at different locations for the ease and facilitation of public. The water electric coolers should be operational 24/7.

# ARTICLE III TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT & PENALTIES

### Section III. 01 Terms and conditions of payment

- a. The general terms and conditions with regard to the payments to be made by the Operator pursuant to the Contract are as under:
- (i) The Contract is based upon fixed Rental payment arrangement between the successful Operator and NHA. NHA shall receive advance quarterly net guaranteed Rental sum amounting to ("amount quoted in the Bid"), notwithstanding the actual revenue collected/generated by the Operator from the Contract Site. The Advance Quarterly Net Guaranteed Rental amount with respect to any year of the Term shall be enhanced at the rate of ten (10) percent of the Advance Quarterly Net Guaranteed Rental of the preceding year, cumulatively.
- (ii) The successful Operator shall deposit the advance guaranteed rentals for three (03) months in NHA designated account. Upon completion of three (03) months, if the successful Operator fails to deposit the advance net guaranteed Rental for next three (03) months by 5th of the calendar month then an amount of Rs. 5,000/- per day shall be charged upto 15th of each calendar month. After delay of 15 days from the due date, contract shall become liable to be terminated under default of Operator including encashment of performance & revenue securities.
- (iii) All payments due under this Contract shall be in Pakistani Rupees;
- (iv) All taxes including income tax shall be paid by the Operator according to the prevailing income Tax Laws in Pakistan over and above net guaranteed rentals; and
- b. The Operator shall deposit three (03) months guaranteed Rentals in advance to NHA in addition to performance security. The Operator shall be refunded the Performance Security upon expiry of the Term, after clearance of all outstanding liabilities of the Operator pursuant to the Contract. Any structural or cosmetic damage caused to the Contract site due to the willful or negligent acts or omissions of the Operator or the employees, agents, servants or representatives thereof, shall be deducted from the Security, provided that deposit of the Security shall not absolve the Operator of its liabilities and duties pursuant to this Contract nor shall it indemnify the Operator in the event of default in paying the Guaranteed Rental to NHA.

# ARTICLE IV TRADE NAME AND ADVERTISEMENT

#### Section IV .01

- a. The Operator shall only use and display its proprietary trade name in marketing and advertisement its services pursuant to this Contract, provided that NHA shall at all times retain a right to display its name and or messages in the form of advertisement at the Contract Site.
- b. The Operator may advertise about the Service Area and other facilities like restaurants, etc. at its own cost and expense, subject to the prior approval of NHA. The Operator shall not display advertisements or signs that are environmentally damaging, dangerous for highway safety, or against the social culture of Pakistan.
- c. During the term, NHA shall retain the right to lease open space within the Contract Site for third party advertisement or any other use as it may deem fit at its sole discretion.
- d. The Operator shall remove all its signboards, and advertisements immediately upon termination or expiry of this Contract. No additional time beyond the contract period shall be granted/allowed for the same. In case of failure by the operator regarding clearance/removal of all its temporary installations, goods, supplies, the same shall become the asset of NHA and operator shall not be entitled for claiming.

# ARTICLE V PUBLIC UTILITIES

### Section V.01 Limit of NHA Obligation

NHA may provide on the Operator's request in a timely manner, such information as it holds or is available in respect of public utilities provided at the Contract Site; provided that NHA shall not be liable to reimburse the Operator for any loss, damage or expense incurred by the Operator as a result of inaccurate or late information being provided by NHA.

#### Section V.02 Facilities

### **Drinking Water Cooler**

The Operator shall arrange at its own all the facilities including drinking water and must ensure provision of electric cooler at Masjids, restaurants & toilets for the use of general public at large.

#### Surveillance cameras

Operator shall be responsible to install and cover all the service area with surveillance cameras round the clock having sufficient storage capacity of data for security purpose at its own cost.

### Section V.03 Application for supply

In relation to the supply of public utilities and services required by the Operator to effectively perform the Services, NHA shall not be responsible for submitting or procuring any applications in respect thereof to the relevant public utility authorities, companies or undertakings charged with the responsibility for the same.

#### Section V.04 Coordination of Works

The Operator shall not be responsible for the costs and expenses of any works that may be carried out by the relevant public authorities and companies at the Contract Site that are not necessary for performance of the Services.

### Section V.05 Access to Contract Site for Public Utilities

The Operator shall permit at any time during the Term the authorized personnel of a public utility provider to have access to the Contract Site for the purpose of:

- a. Routine maintenance of any public utility already located within the Contract Site;
- b. The strengthening, replacing or upgrading of any public utility already located within the Contract Site;

- c. Reinstating any foundations, structures, buildings, pavements, cabling and the like which may be disturbed or affected by reason of such works undertaken by a public utility provider, or
- d. Any other work including the installation of any new additional services of the public utility provider within the Contract Site.

### Section V.06 Payment for Utilities

The Operator shall be responsible for the payment of all utility bills and POL/Maintenance of stand by generators for the Contract Site in its area of jurisdiction including but not limited to street lights to be paid by Operator of Service Area on actual basis in accordance with the provisions of Article II of this Contract.

# ARTICLE VI THE NHA REPRESENTATIVE AND EMPLOYEES OF THE OPERATOR

### Section VI.01 Employer Representative

The Employer representative for field supervision will be concerned General Manager (Project/Maintenance) Region. He will supervise Contract site through PD/DD (Maintenance/Revenue) and will be responsible to implement the Contractual Obligations of Operator.

### Section VI.02 Staff of the Operator

- a. The Operator shall, at its own cost and expense, hire the services of skilled and unskilled staff ("Employees") for the operation, management and supervision of Service Area. List of the employees that shall be hired for this purpose shall be maintained with the Supervisor of the concerned field staff as a record for verification.
- b. NHA may in its sole discretion deem an employee unfit to perform services at under this contract. Such employee shall be immediately removed by the Operator besides taking other course of action required as per Legal way and Law upon the request of NHA and shall not be reappointed to perform any work under this contract except with the written consent of NHA. In the event that NHA elects to exercise its power under this provision, the Operator shall have no right to any compensation whatsoever for any loss consequential to the exercise of such power.
- c. The Employees shall be in proper uniform and must be capable of providing services pursuant to the Contract in an honest, courteous and efficient manner.
- d. If at any time after provision of the List, the Operator desires to recruit or dismiss an employee, the Operator shall forthwith notify NHA of such recruitment or dismissal, to update list of employees all the times.
- e. The Operator shall promptly notify NHA if with respect to an employee (s) any disciplinary action has been commenced or taken by the Operator, or (II) any criminal proceedings have been initiated or concluded.
- f. The Operator shall comply with all prevailing laws, rules and regulations of Pakistan with regard to rights and obligations of the Employees.

# ARTICLE VII DEFAULT

### Section VII.01 Defaulting events along with penalty

- a. The occurrence of any one or more of the following events shall constitute an event of default by the Operator under this Contract:
  - i. Addition or deletion of any business/facility without prior written agreement with the Employer i.e. NHA;
  - ii. Indulgence in fraudulent acts;
  - iii. Failure to promptly reimburse NHA for any loss or damage caused thereto attributable at an act or omission of the Operator;
  - iv. Delay in commencement or discontinuance by the Operator in the performance of obligations under this contract;
  - v. Failure to pay the Advance Net Guaranteed Rental amount to NHA timely as committed in this Contract.
  - vi. Insolvency, bankruptcy or liquidation of the Operator;
  - vii. Failure by the Operator to perform any component of the contract in a manner specified in the contract.
- b. If the Operator commits a default as set out herein above, NHA shall be entitled to exercise the following rights in addition to any or all remedies available to NHA under the law:
  - i. Encash performance security and Rental security.
  - ii. NHA may terminate the Contract immediately alongwith blacklisting of the Operator on the recommendation of GM (RoW-Rev)/(GM Region);
  - iii. NHA may fine the Operator upon each occurrence of a defaulting event. The fine shall range from Rupees ten thousand (Rs. 10,000/-) to Rupees one Lac (Rs.100,000/-), the exact fine depending on the severity of the defaulting event to be determined by concerned Regional GM alongwith a representative from Rev-RoW Section nominated by GM (Rev-RoW). The recommendations regarding imposition of penalty will be submitted before Chairman NHA for the final decision; and

# ARTICLE VIII EXPIRY AND TERMINATION

### Section VIII.01 Expiry Date of Contract

Contract shall be valid for a period of Five (05) years from the date of issuance of Letter of Commencement subject to clause 1.7.

### Section VIII.02 Early Termination of the Contract

- a. NHA shall have the right to terminate this Contract or particular services being rendered pursuant to this Contract, for convenience as determined in its sole discretion, at any time during the Term. NHA may exercise this right by furnishing a written notice to the Operator of its action to do so, that the Contract is being terminated. Such termination shall be effective following the date as mentioned in such notice. Thereafter, all references to the obligations under this Contract shall be deem to refer only to any particular part of the obligations with respect to which this Agreement has not been terminated.
- b. In case NHA fails to provide peaceful possession of contract site, free of all encumbrances, the Operator may serve notice to NHA in writing, specifying the default and requiring NHA to rectify the same within sixty (60) days from the date of such notice. If NHA fails to remedy/rectify the said default within the given time period, the Operator shall have the right to issue final notice for termination of contract to NHA, which shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of the Termination Notice and in that case NHA will release the Securities/deposits of the Operator.

# ARTICLE IX FORCE MAJEURE

#### Section IX.01 General

Force Majeure means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of either Party and whose occurrence could not have been reasonably foreseen at the date of running Contract by exercise of due diligence; whereof, which makes performance of the Contract impossible in the sense or mode contemplated by the Parties or so impractical as to be considered so impossible under the new circumstances. It includes, but is not limited to war, invasion, riots, insurrection, civil commotion, acts of terrorism in that particular locality only, unusual flood, major earthquake, volcanic activity, radiation or chemical contamination, ionizing radiation, explosions, serious amendment in legislation by Government, judgment/order passed by the Honorable Supreme Court regarding termination of the subject Contract or its any portion, or any act of God.

### Section IX.02 Notice of Force Majeure

If either Party is unable to perform or fulfill any of its obligations under this Contract, as a result of an event of Force Majeure, it shall serve notice within twenty (20) days of the occurrence thereof to the other Party.

### Section IX.03 Termination/Suspension due to Force Majeure

Neither party shall by reason of such eventuality, be entitled to terminate the Contract nor either party shall raise any claim for damages in respect of such non-performance. Contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such eventuality has come to an end or caused to exist provided that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this Contract is delayed by reason of any such eventuality for a period exceeding fifteen (15) days, the Parties shall meet and review in good faith the desirability and conditions of terminating this Contract or suspension of the contract up to maximum 182 days.

### Section IX.04 Extension of Time due to Force Majeure

If the operations at site remain suspended for more than 15 days but become operational within 182 days during the currency of contract, the Operator will be granted extension of time for compensating him in performance of contract. The Extension of Time shall be exactly equal to that time period, for which the sites were not operational due to event(s) of Force Majeure.

#### Section IX.05 Continuation of the Contract

The Parties acknowledge that it is in their mutual interest that to the extent possible, decisions concerning Force Majeure shall be directed towards the continued operation of the Contract for the full duration of the Term as provided in this Contract.

# ARTICLE X TRANSFER UPON EARLY TERMINATION OR EXPIRY

### Section X.01 Transfer upon early termination or expiry

- a. Upon early termination or expiry of this Contract in accordance with the terms and conditions set out herein, the Operator shall immediately cease to enjoy rights under the contract and shall remove all the Employees, workmen, employees, servants, agents engaged in operation of contract immediately on the date on which the termination or expiry takes effect and clear the site for NHA or duly nominated representative thereof, by handing over the peaceful possession of site in a properly maintained & operational condition.
- b. The NHA shall, inspect the Contract Sites and assets thereon including all civil works, installations, equipments and facilities and shall issue an inventory to Operator specifying the condition of the assets thereon and whether Operator has failed to abide by any of its obligations under the Contract.
- c. Upon early termination or expiry of this Contract, the rights and entitlements of Operator pursuant to this Contract shall revert to, vest in or remain vested in the NHA, as the case may be.
- d. Operator shall ensure that the Contract Site and other assets under the contract upon the date of early termination or expiry are free of all liens and charges.
- e. If the Contract is terminated pursuant to Sections VIII.02 (a) or VIII.02 (b), then an amount equal to the assessed value of the facility by the designated committee (of both the parties) shall be reimbursed to the Operator as demobilization charges.
- f. Notwithstanding any dispute between the Parties or any claim against NHA, the Operator shall hand over vacant and peaceful possession of the Contract Site and other assets thereon to NHA in accordance with the terms and conditions as set out in this Contract. Any dispute between the Parties or any claims of the Operator against NHA shall not in any case entitle the Operator to refuse or delay the transfer of these assets to NHA. Failure by the Operator to do so in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Contract shall be treated as encroachment and unauthorized occupation by the Operator and may be dealt with by NHA under Section 12 of the National Highway Authority Act, 1991 as amended in 2001.

# ARTICLE XI RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever arises between the Concessionaire and the NHA in connection with or arising out of the Contract or performance of the obligations whether during the progress of the obligations or after its completion or after is termination, abandonment or breach of the Contract, it shall in the first place be referred to:

- I. The Employer Representative General Manger (Rev-RoW), NHA shall be served with a notice containing the cause of action, mentioning facts of the case and relief sought. The General Manager (Rev-RoW) shall decide the dispute within twenty-eight (28) days of the receipt of such notice or any extended period with the mutual consent of parties.
- II. If the Concessionaire is dissatisfied with the decision of the General Manager (Rev-RoW) or if the decision of the General Manger (Rev-RoW) is not forthcoming within the stipulated or extended period, the Concessionaire may within two (02) weeks from the receipt of the decision of the General Manager (Rev-RoW) or expiry of twenty-eight days' time refer the matter to the Member (Finance) along with the cause of action, mentioning facts of the case and relief sought. The Member (Finance) will act as a Sole Adjudicator and shall decide the matte within twenty-eight (28) days from the date of submission or any extended period with the mutual consent of parties.
- III. The Concessionaire, if dissatisfied with the decision of the Adjudicator shall have the right to serve Notice for Intention to commence litigation within twenty-eight (28) days of receipt of the Adjudicator's decision or within twenty-eight (28) days after the expiry of the period stipulated herein above for decision of the Adjudicator in case he fails to give decision. Place of litigation shall be Islamabad.

Provided however, that the parties shall have the right at resolution of disputes amicably within fifty-six (56) days of service of Notice for Intention to commence litigation and the litigation may be commenced at instance of either party, in case of failure of amicable settlement of the dispute, after fifty-six (56) days period from the date of service of the Notice of Intention to commence litigation.

# ARTICLE XII MISCELLANEOUS

### Section XII.01 Variations in Writing

This Contract may be varied or amended only by the mutual consent of the Parties. All such variations and amendments shall be binding only if they are in writing and are signed by duly authorized representatives of the Parties. Any addition or deletion of obligations, rights or business will be effected in form of a V.O. to the Contract.

### Section XII.02 Waivers

- a. No waiver by either Party of any default by the other in the performance of any of the provisions of this Contract shall operate or be construed as a waiver of any other or further default whether of a like or different character.
- b. The failure by either Party to insist on any occasion upon the performance of the terms, conditions and provisions of this Contract or time or other indulgence granted by one Party to the other shall not thereby act as a waiver of such breach or acceptance of any variation.

# Section XII.03 Insurance Coverage from 'AA' Rated Insurance Companies.

- a. The Operator shall obtain and maintain during the pendency of contract, insurance for all assets of Employer handed over to Operator for performing services under this contract against loss & damage due to any reason.
- b. The Operator shall obtain and maintain during the pendency of contract, insurance for Operator's Equipment and other things brought onto the Site by the Operator, for a sum sufficient to provide for their replacement at the Site.
- c. Operator shall obtain and maintain comprehensive health insurance for its entire staff working on Contract Site, alongwith mandatory contribution to E.O.B.I. and other labour Law requisites.
- d. Operator shall maintain during the currency of contract, insurance for all its employees working on Contract Site against injury or death having a minimum coverage of Rs.500,000/-in case of death and Rs.200,000/- for each case of injury/disability with unlimited number of incidents.
- e. The premium for such insurances shall be paid by the Operator.

### Section XII.04 Compliance with Government Rules and Regulations

The Operator shall, during the Term of this Contract, strictly comply with all laws, polices, guidelines, rules and regulations in vogue or hereafter promulgated by the Government of Pakistan. All policies, guidelines, rules and regulations and all applicable laws, shall be read and made integral parts of this Contract.

### Section XII.05 Headings; Grammatical Usage; Names

Words in the singular form are deem to include the plural when the sense requires, and the plural shall similarly include the singular. Where the government agencies are named, the name used is deem to include any successor agency in the event the name is changed or the relevant functions are transferred.

### Section X1I.06 Non-Relief from Accrued Liability

The termination of this Contract shall not relieve either Party of any liability that may have already accrued pursuant to the terms of this Contract.

### Section XII.07 Applicable Law

This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the Laws of Pakistan.

### Section XII.08 Limit of Rights

The rights given under this Contract to the Operator in respect of the land made available to it do not confer upon the Operator any proprietary or installation right, title or interest over such land, nor bears any right to mortgage or pledge any part of the respective Service Area to any financial institution, whatsoever.
