Subject: <u>The 395th Meeting of the NHA Executive Board Held</u> on May 27, 2022 at Islamabad.

Introduction

The 395th meeting of the National Highway Authority's Executive Board was held at 0900 hours on May 27, 2022 at the Auditorium of NHA Headquarters, Islamabad. Capt. (Retd.) Muhammad Khurram Agha, Chairman, NHA presided over the meeting.

The meeting commenced with recitation of verses from the Holy Quran with Urdu translation and Darood Sharif.

The Chairman allowed Secretary, NHA to start formal Board proceedings on the agenda.

Decision

The NHA Executive Board approved the award of works of Contract No. SM-KP-20-5006(P) to lowest bidder M/s Pasban Constructor JV M/s Ghulam Muhammad Khan & Co. at the bid price amounting to Rs.124,922,548/- (Rupees one hundred twenty-four million, nine hundred twenty-two thousand, five hundred & fortyeight only), which is at-par with the Engineer's Estimate.

The NHA Executive Board approved the award of Periodic Maintenance (Structural Overlay) Contract No. PM-KP-20-2004(P) to the lowest evaluated bidder i.e. M/s Pasban Constructor JV Ghulam Muhammad Khan & Co, at their quoted bid i.e. Rs.593,556,509/- (Rupees five hundred ninety-three million, five hundred fifty-six thousand, five hundred & nine only), at par with Engineer's Cost Estimate, based on CSR 2014.

Agenda Item 5

Revised PC-I for Construction of Kot Pindi Das Interchange at Km 30 on Lahore – Islamabad Motorway (M-2), District Sheikhupura

The NHA Executive Board deferred the subject agenda item with the direction to resubmit the case with approved Deputy Commissioner rates of land compensation and undertaking from the Contractor for bid validity.

Agenda Item 6

Presentation by Chief NTRC for Fixation of Base Price for the Toll Plazas on National Highways and Motorways Network

Decision

The NHA Executive Board agreed to adopt the way forward suggested by NTRC for fixation of base price during the award of toll plazas on National Highways and Motorways network where ETTM systems are not installed.

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The Board also approved:

- a. Electronic Toll & Traffic Management (ETTM) Systems having Automatic Vehicle Classification should be installed on remaining network. Main arteries N-5 and N-55 should be given priority.
- b. Procurement of five (05) sets of LiDAR traffic counting sensors by Revenue Section NHA. Revenue Section also start the process for procuring services for traffic surveys to carry out the exercise for traffic counts throughout the year.
- c. Availability of updated Monthly Traffic Variation Factors at least by conducting three years (365 x 3 = 1,095 days) traffic counts on 70 strategic locations at NHA network. For this purpose, a PC-II prepared by NTRC at a cost of Rs.475 million submitted to MoC in February, 2022 for approval of DDWP.

Decision

The NHA Executive Board approved the award of Design Consultancy Services Contract to Directorate of Design & Consultancy Engineer in Chief Branch, on Direct Contracting basis, as per PPRA Rule 42(f), for Detailed Design and Cost Estimate of proposed Flyover at Defence Chowk, Rawalpindi at Km 1534 on N-5 at agreed Design Fee of 2.0% (+ GST) of the project cost."
