1. National Highway Authority (NHA) invites sealed bids from prospective bidders who can prove their eligibility and qualification as mentioned in the Bidding Documents for Operation and Management of following Police Fine Collection Units on National Highways (N-5). The subject services will be hired for the period **ending till 30.06.2024**.

- 2. The bidding shall be done through NHA e-Bidding System www.ebidding.nha.gov.pk. Prospective Bidders are required to create their "On-line User Account" for participation in the bidding. User Guide and video tutorial, illustrating the steps to create "On-line User Account", are available on homepage of NHA e-Bidding System website. Access to 'NHA e-Bidding System' for bidding, will be granted upon submission of pre-requisite documents as per guide line. e-Bids submitted, by using NHA e-bidding system, will only be considered, whereas other bids will be rejected. User Guide and video tutorial for Preparation & Submission of e-Bids are available on homepage of NHA e-Bidding System website.
- 3. Bidders are required to be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) and having a valid PEC license in Operators Category "O-5 or above" for F.Y. 2022-23 as well as possess NTN and to be on ATL of FBR.
- **4.** Bid security of Rs. 500,000/- in the form, amount and validity period as mentioned in bidding documents must be accompanied with **"Technical Bid"**.
- **5.** All prospective Bidder(s) who has been declared defaulters, de-barred, blacklisted or have shortfall in current contracts within NHA are not eligible to participate in bidding process. However, the bidder(s) whose case are/is already sub-judice or dispute/arbitration is in process shall not be treated as Shortfallers/Defaulter (s) and will be considered for bidding on case to case basis subject to approval of NHA.
- 6. All prospective bidders are requested to submit, written confirmation (Power of Attorney) authorizing the person to submit the bid on his/their behalf. Written confirmation from

owner/head, authorizing the signatory to Bid must also be accompanied with the **"Technical Bid".** 

- 7. Complete set of bidding documents containing details, terms & conditions, method of procurement (single stage two envelop procedure) submission of e-bids bid security, bid validity, opening of e-bid, envelops criteria etc., will be available on NHA website (www.ebidding.nha.gov.pk) on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 for download free of cost. Bidders are also advised to follow the NHA e-bidding website for updates of bids schedule and addendums (if any).
- 8. The e-Bids must be prepared and submitted through NHA e-Bidding system in accordance with the instructions contained in the Bidding Documents. Hard copy of e-Bids generated through NHA e-Bidding system, must reach at the address mentioned below on or before 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 till 1200 Hours. Technical e-Bids (submitted through NHA e-Bidding system) and envelope containing hard copy of Technical e-Bids, will be opened on the same day at 1230 Hours.
- **9.** All prospective bidders shall provide following undertaking as a mandatory requirement on stamp paper of Rs. 100/ duly attested by Oath Commissioner stating that:
  - a) He/his firm is not blacklisted and he is not defaulter of any Government Department.
  - b) They have gone through all Bidding documents/Request for Proposal (RFP).
  - c) The information/record given with the bidding documents are correct and they have not concealed any relevant information.
- 10. The prospective bidders are directed to provide the following documents along with Technical Proposals, failing to provide the required documents will be consider Non Responsive:
  - a) Bidder's Application/Letter of Intension to participate in a particular toll plaza must be attached with the Technical Proposals.
  - b) Technical & Financial Bids shall be signed & stamped by the authorized person.
  - c) In case of Individual Copy of CNIC along with Affidavit as owner of the company duly attested by Notary Public / Oath Commissioner.
  - d) In case of Firm Form C issued by Registrar of Firm along with partnership deed / or partners name with distribution of shares.
  - e) In case of Company SECP certificate along with Memorandum of Association and Article of Association.
  - f) In case of Authorized Representative Affidavit must be issued from Owner/Directors of the Firm/Company and attested by Notary Public / Oath Commissioner, in respect of the person given authorization with his sample of signatures.
  - g) All other required undertakings and affidavit must be attested by Oath Commissioner.
- **11.** The bidder shall provide an undertaking on Judicial Stamp paper duly notarized that the bidder is not defaulter of any Govt. Deptt. Including NHA, as well as not blacklisted anywhere from Pakistan.
- **12.** The bidders providing unsubstantiated and / or incorrect information are liable to legal action and disqualification.
- **13.** The Authority reserves the right to reject any/all bids at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid in accordance with PPRA's Rules 2004 (as amended in 2021).

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
