on June 22, 2023 at Islamabad

Introduction

The 438th meeting of the National Highway Authority Executive Board was held at 0900 hours on June 22, 2023 at the Auditorium of NHA Headquarters, Islamabad. Capt. (Retd.) Muhammad Khurram Agha, Chairman, NHA presided over the meeting.

Agenda Item 1

Award of Works: Construction of Yarik-Tank Road (Length:35 KM) D.I Khan Development Package

Decision

The NHA Executive Board approved the award of Works for – "Construction of Yarik - Tank Road (Length:35Km) D.I Khan Development Package" to M/s NPI Construction & Engineering at their evaluated bid price of Rs.4,750,981,988/- (Rupees four billion, seven hundred fifty million, nine hundred eighty-one thousand, nine hundred & eighty-eight only), which is 33.35% above the Engineer's



Estimate of Rs.3,562,835,161/- (based on CSR-2022) subject to approval of revised PC-I by CDWP.

Agenda Item 3

Report of Committee Constituted by NHA Executive Board on the Matter of Career Progression of NHA Special Service Cadre (NSSC) Employees

Decision

The NHA Executive Board after thorough deliberations, approved the following, for career progression of NHA Special Service Cadre (NSSC) employees:

- a. Where no post is available in higher grades, new post(s) are created in Special Cadre to give career path to employees.
- b. Number of new post(s) has been determined based on the 'factor' existing in posts of regular establishment. This factor is calculated in the following manner:

Factor = <u>Number of posts in promotion share in higher grade in regular establishment</u>
Total Number of Posts in feeding cadre in regular establishment

c. This factor is used in calculating number of post(s) of special service cadre, which have been reserved for promotion in each grade, proportionate to the number of post(s) available in regular establishment.



- d. In few cases, adjustment/rationalization of posts have been done as per need of the authority to give reasonable career path to special service cadre employees.
- e. NSSC employees will have to meet the eligibility criteria provided in the NHA Appointment & Promotion Rules 1995 for consideration for promotion by the Selection Committee.
- f. Strength of Special Service Cadre will be maintained separately and timely notification of abolition of post(s) that become vacant will be made regularly after the holding of DPC meetings.
- g. Based on the scheme/principles explained above, 118 new post(s) in promotion share in different grades are created in Special Service Cadre. Overall, 493 posts are reserved in promotion share of the NSSC employees as shown in the table below:

The Board also approved renaming of Audit Committee as Audit & Accounts Committee and Secretary, NHA will henceforth act as Secretary of the Committee. Furthermore, the Board agreed with following suggestions of Audit Committee for improving organizational performance and directed NHA:

- a. To focus on closing/finalizing Annual Maintenance Plans relating to preceding years for which a comprehensive strategy must be formulated with a cut of dates. More so, aspect of awarding contracts against previous year AMP's must be discouraged.
- b. To standardize its toll plazas network and explore new avenues beside adoption of modern techniques to enhance its revenues.



- c. To review its administrative expenditure structure to ensure optimum and efficient utilization of funds by devising a detailed policy/guideline.
- d. To adopt market best practices for capacity building of human resource of NHA like special courses/ trainings in top rated institutions and allowing employees to register with professional bodies such as PEC, ICAP, ICMAP, etc.
- e. To explore more profitable options for the placement of its pension funds for which proposals must be shared with Board of Trustees.
- f. To introduce Incentive Schemes to encourage employees by adopting market best practices, such as incentive in career progression & financial benefits for attaining higher qualifications and expertise.
