PROMOTION AGAINST THE POST OF LDC (BS-09) VACANT IN PROMOTION SHARE HAVING NO FEEDING CADRE

Few vacancies of Lower Division Clerks (BS-09) are lying vacant against promotion share, where no feeding cadre is available for consideration of promotion. It has been decided by the appointing authority to fill these posts with amongst the eligible regular employees of NHA held in the lower scales (BS-01 to BS-08) on merit.

- 02. NHA Rules are silent with regard to filling of these posts. However, in all matters not specifically provided in NHA Rules, the Rules applicable to the employees of the Federal Government shall apply.
- 03. Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 provides following method of appointment through promotion against the post of LDC (BS-09):-

Designation and	CONDITIONS	FOR PROMOTION (GOP)
BPS of the post	Person eligible	Conditions of eligibility
LDC (BS-09)	Employees holding posts in BPS-08 and below.	

04. Keeping the above in view, all regular employees (excluding special service cadre employees) of NHA in BS-01 to BS-08 who are interested to be considered for promotion to the post of LDC (BS-09) and fulfilling the eligibility conditions for promotion as mentioned above may apply through formal application duly recommended by concerned GM and supported with attested copy of matric and NITB certificates.
