OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - FILING OF INCOME TAX RETURNS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2019:  
REQUEST REGARDING.

Kindly refer to the subject noted above.

01. With due reverence, it is stated that filing of tax return is a national obligation under the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001. In this regard, section 114 of the Ordinance, stipulates that all salaried employees whose income exceeds Rs.600,000/- during a fiscal year are chargeable to tax and hence are liable to file their income tax returns as well as wealth statements u/s 116 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001. Owing to ignorance of law, every year sizable number of employees do not file their tax returns, thus resulting decrease in taxpaying population of the country.

02. In view of the foregoing, your good office is requested to instruct each and every individual serving in your Division/Organization and subordinate offices/organizations to file their returns of income without fail in the best interest of revenue on or before the end of deadline of 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 for the Tax Year 2019.

03. I also take this opportunity to apprise all the non-filers of tax returns through your august office that Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 has prescribed imposition of financial penalty u/s 182 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001, as well as initiation of prosecution proceedings u/s 191, if convicted by the Honorable Special Court (Customs, Taxation and Anti-Smuggling).
