
ISO-QMS Certification of NHA: Establishment of Quality Management Cell (ISO) and Way Forward

# **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board approved to:

a. Establish a Quality Assurance Cell on permanent basis at NHA HQs for sustainability and continuation of Quality Management System (ISO 9001:2015) mentioned below:

- b. A full time Director (ISO Implementation & QMS Audit) along with dedicated staff to be posted at HQs.
- c. For the time being, additional charge of Zonal ISO Coordinators shall be assigned to the available ISO-QMS certified lead auditors and trained officers of NHA. However, wherever possible dedicated coordinators shall be posted.
- d. The officers/staff posted or assigned additional charge of post as per designations given in organogram or assigned supervision of the Quality Assurance Cell, shall be entitled for grant of QMS special allowance @ 20% of their running pay per month but not exceeding to Rs.12,000/- till holding the charge in QMS Cell.
- e. The services of ISO Consultant shall be hired to supervise and assist to maintaining and continual improvement of ISO quality management system.
- f. The expenses relating to ISO-QMS activities shall be charged to NHA 1% establishment account.
- g. The quality assurance cell will develop the letter head and noting format with logo of ISO-QMS for all official communications and place the ISO Certificate in various offices of NHA and on NHA website.





The Board acknowledged the commendable efforts of the Chairman, NHA and the officers/officials involved in the ISO-QMS certification for NHA. The Board recommended the Chairman, NHA to grant honorarium equivalent to one month running basic pay to officers/officials, who worked in the project of ISO-QMS certification of NHA.

Variation Order No. 07: Consultancy Service for Design Review, Construction Supervision and Contract Administration of Lowari Tunnel Project

Variation Order No. 08: Construction of Lowari Tunnel Project

### **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board approved Variation Order No. 08 against Civil Works Contract of Lowari Tunnel Project at amounting to net effect of (+) Rs. 434,870,923 (+8.010%) with accumulative variation of (+) Rs. 4,816,082,223.00 (88.71%) up to Vo No. 8 and for revised cost of civil works contract to Rs. 10,244,850,872.00.

The Board directed to utilize the jet fans temporarily installed in Lowari tunnel in other tunnels of KKH after permanent fixing of new jet fans.





The Board further directed the GM (LTP) to take up the matter with the concerned Commissioner to stop entrance of smoke emitting vehicles in the tunnel as it is hazardous.

Revised Variation Order No. 01 of M/s Dawn Construction Co for Periodic Maintenance Work between Km 796+00 – 800+00 (N-55) Taunsa Urban Area (Contract No. PM-2015-16-PS-04)

The NHA Executive Board approved revised Variation Order No 1 of M/s Dawn Construction Co for Periodic Maintenance Work between Km 796+00 – 800+00 (N-55) Taunsa Urban Area costing to Rs.(0.907) Million with revised contract cost Rs.206.753 Million with variation of -0.44 % with Extension of Time (EoT) to the Contractor from August 11, 2018 to May 10, 2019 (09 Months) due to increase in scope of work.

## Agenda Item 7

Construction of Shatial – Thor Nullah Bypass Project on the KKH (N-35): Payment of Idling Claims for all Stoppages of Work, not attributed to the M/s Hakas Contractor

#### **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board approved as follows:

- a. Amount of Rs. 250 Million against claim related to idling claims for period from June 02, 2013 to July 25, 2017.
- b. Extra ordinary EOT due to forced stoppage of work by the locals/reasons beyond Contractor's control, from May 23, 2016 to November 30, 2020, to regularize stoppage of work from May 23, 2016 to November 30, 2018 and time required for construction of remaining 70% + 33% work (additional 10 KM).
- c. Principle approval for variation order to include 10 KM road from KM 32 to KM 42 (Part of R-1 Package) from sitting contractor, M/s Hakas (Pvt.) Ltd., as part of it's existing contract, as approved by WAPDA & handed over in August 2018.
