#### Agenda Item 2

Development of E-Procurement/E-Tendering System for National Highway Authority (Services Required From PITB)

## **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board recommended award of negotiating, direct tendering of E-Procurement/ E-tendering software development contract, along with the Admin approval, Technical & Expenditure Sanction for procurement of the subject software services at an estimated cost of Rs.40 Million from Punjab Information Technology Board (PITB), Government of Punjab, after taking necessary approval from Principal Accounting Officer (PAO) i.e. Secretary Ministry of Communications, clearance by the Steering Committee and NOC by the NITB.

## Agenda Item 4

Lowari Tunnel Project and Access Roads PC-I (3rd Revision)

#### **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board considered the working paper regarding the PC-I (3<sup>rd</sup> Revision) of Lowari Tunnel & Access Road Project and directed as follows:

- a. The current project which comprises of Package-I & II be included in revised PC-I (3<sup>rd</sup> Revision) should be based on actual cost by excluding the costs of electrical & mechanical works and also elaborate all factors that caused delays.
- b. Prepare separate PC-I for electrical and mechanical works along with operational & complementary buildings, control center and bridges of South & North Access Roads of Package-II of Lowari Tunnel Project. NHA to adopt EPC contracting mode for the subject works.

Construction of Additional Carriageway Torkham-Jalalabad Road Project Afghanistan (ACW TJRP): 2<sup>nd</sup> Revision of PC-I

## **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board deliberated upon and deferred the working paper regarding 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised PC-I (March 2019) of Construction of Additional Carriageway Torkham-Jalalabad Road Project Afghanistan (ACW TJRP) and directed to rationalize the cost of 2<sup>nd</sup> revised PC-I to complete the original scope of work at first stage and present before the Board.

The Board further directed to request the Government of Pakistan for releasing of funds to finish the existing scope of works by excluding the cost of three bridges. The proposal for construction of bridges will be considered at appropriate stage.

#### **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board reconsidered its earlier decision made in 318th meeting held on April 09, 2019 and granted the Admin approval, Technical & expenditure Sanction for procurement of the Technical Support & Maintenance of Permanent Weigh Stations on National Highways and Motorways along with provision of connectivity with operation centre at NHA HQ at an estimated cost of Rs.230 Million with the direction to implement the project in phases starting from fourteen (14) critical weigh stations.

Approval for Award of "Rehabilitation of N-25 from Km 24 to Km 27 (Hub City Portion)" of Balochistan South Region under AMP 2017-18

## **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board rejected the award of "Rehabilitation of N-25 from KM: 24 to KM: 27 (Hub City Portion)" F.Y 2017-18 of Balochistan South Region, Contract No. RH-BS-2017-18-01 with the direction to retender the award of works with 15 days response time for bidder.

Procurement of Fresh Contract for Provision of Internet Facility at NHA HQs

## **Decision**

The NHA Executive Board approved award of contract to M/s Wateen, the lowest evaluated bidder at quoted bid price of Rs.2,632,500/- (Rupees two million, six hundred thirty two thousand, five hundred only) (Rs.1,463/- per Mbps rate and monthly recurring charges as Rs. 219,375/-) for the period of one year.

The Board granted approval for time extension of internet services of M/s Multinet till the installation and successful commissioning of new connection to keep official work streamline for entire NHA HQs.
