Agenda Item 2

Maintenance and Improvement of KKH (KM 294 – KM 471) due to Construction of Diamer Bhasha Dam Project & Other Dams on River Indus along KKH

The Supreme Appellate Court of Gilgit Baltistan has taken Suo-Moto Notice of the extremely dilapidated condition of KKH from Dasu to Raikot Bridge and has directed to initiate the maintenance works immediately. Further, the Honorable Court has directed, in its order dated March 03, 2020, to General Manager (Gilgit Baltistan) to utilize all his possible efforts to start rehabilitation works on the poor sections of KKH and come up with the progress report on the next date of hearing.

The Chairman, NHA was directed to ensure compliance of Court directives. Further, the Chairman NHA had already accorded the Technical Sanction and in-principle approval of the proposed Engineer's Estimates.

The Member (Engg. Coord) NHA provided the subject working paper for presenting in the Executive Board containing following proposal to comply the order of the Supreme Appellate Court, Gilgit Baltistan:

> a. Six (06) Schemes for maintenance of KKH from Dasu to Raikot amounting to Rs.2,877.96 million to be carried as deposit work from funds released by WAPDA.



b. In-principle approval to hire the construction supervision consultant utilizing the funds released by WAPDA.

Being a time specific court case, the Chairman, NHA approved to circulate the working paper among the Executive Board Members for approval.

The subject working paper was circulated among NHA Executive Board Members to peruse/approve the proposal mentioned in Para-5.3 above vide letter dated March 06, 2020. The Board has approved the same agenda item through circulation. However, same is included for record and information of the Board.

Agenda Item 3PC-I for Construction of Interchange on MotorwayM-1 atKheshgi District Nowshera

Decision

The NHA Executive Board recommended the PC-I for Construction of Interchange on Motorway (M-1) at Kheshgi, District Nowshera at a cost of Rs.837.204 million for approval of DDWP subject to the following:

- a. Design Review & Supervision Charges be rationalized from 5% to 3% of project cost.
- b. Traffic count study and economic analysis details be made part of the PC-I.

Decision

<u>Agenda Item 6</u> Modified PC-I for Khyberpass Economic Corridor Project (KPEC)

Decision

The Board further directed that the PC-I cost should include:

a. As per policy approved by the Board, the NH&MP components.

The NHA Executive Board approved the award of "Periodic Maintenance Work (Rehabilitation) Between Km: 82 to Km: 95 on N-80 pertaining to Punjab North Regions under Annual Maintenance Plan 2018-19" to lowest evaluated bidder M/s HRK & Company at Evaluated Bid Price of Rs.263,876,997.00 (Rupees two hundred sixty-three million, eight hundred seventy-six thousand, nine hundred ninety-seven only), which is 24.786% below than Engineer's Estimate amounting to Rs.350,834,948.00 based on CSR-2014 with 10% additional Performance Security in addition to Performance Security (10%) already stipulated in "Appendix-A" to Bid.
